Minutes of the Meeting:

The meeting began with an address by **Rev. Fr. Principal, Dr. Nabor Lakra, S.J.** Fr. Nabor began by welcoming the new members of the IQAC. Ravi Hemant Kujur, S.J. also opined that a daylong workshop is needed to understand the seven criteria.

Dr. Sanjay Kumar wanted to have a proforma based on which the Academic Audit can be performed across all departments. It was decided by the house that Internal Audit can be done every year and External Audit once in three years.
