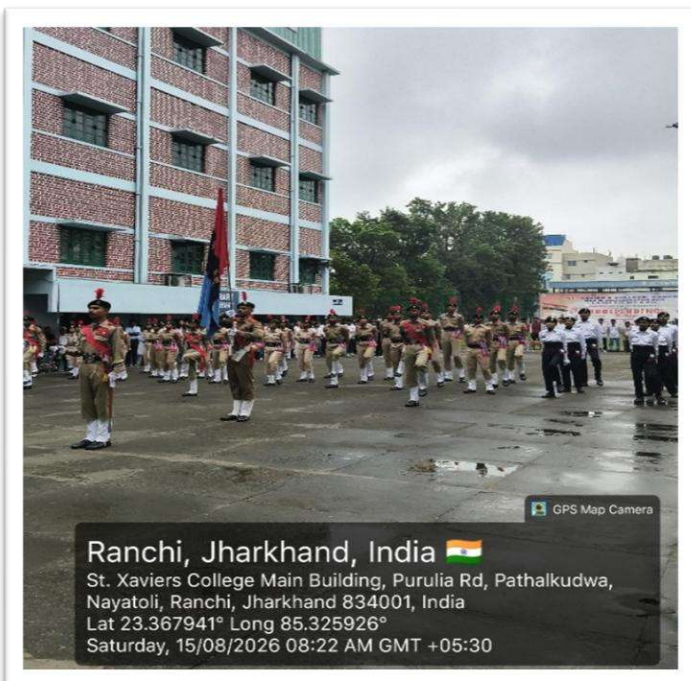
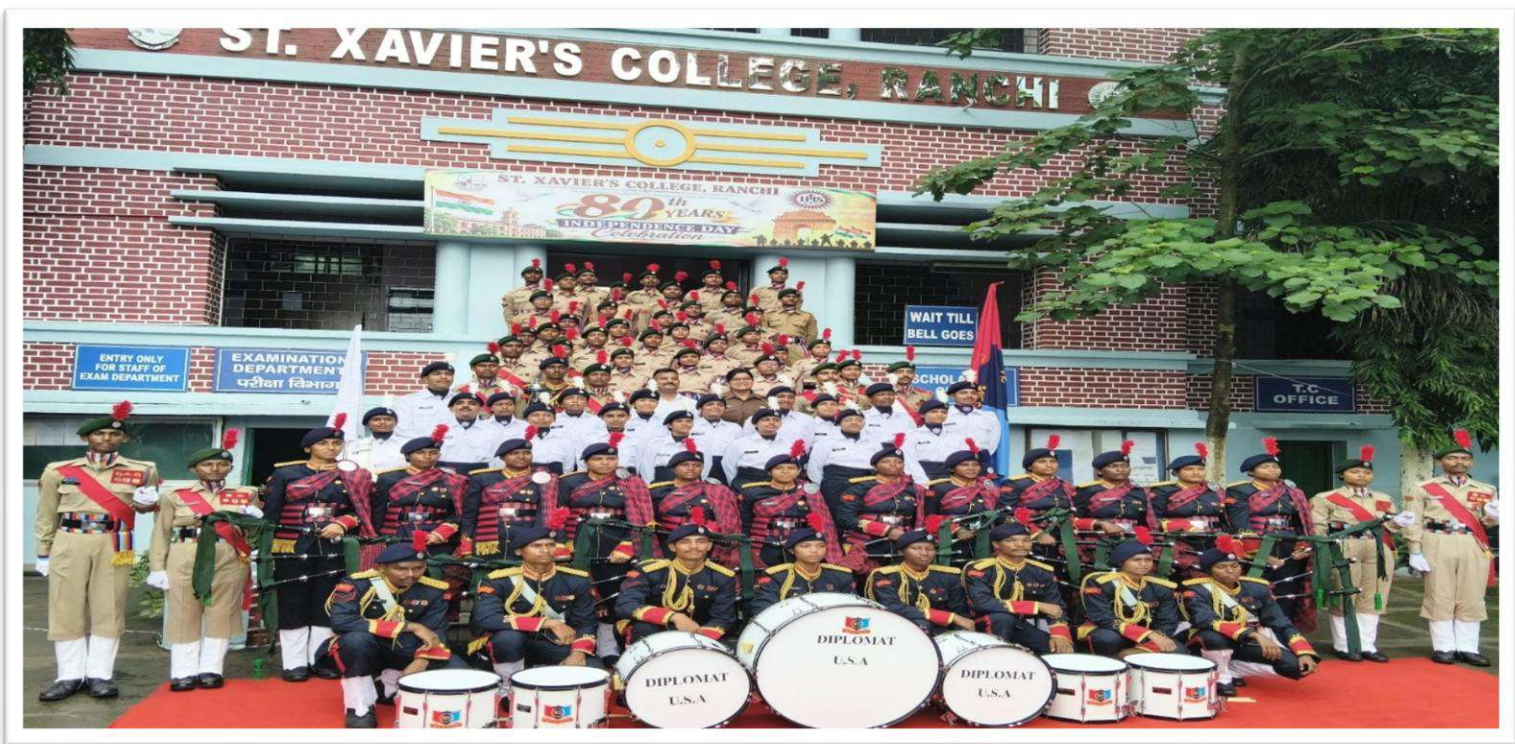
"A Nation United, A Future Bright."

TIME: 0900 hrs

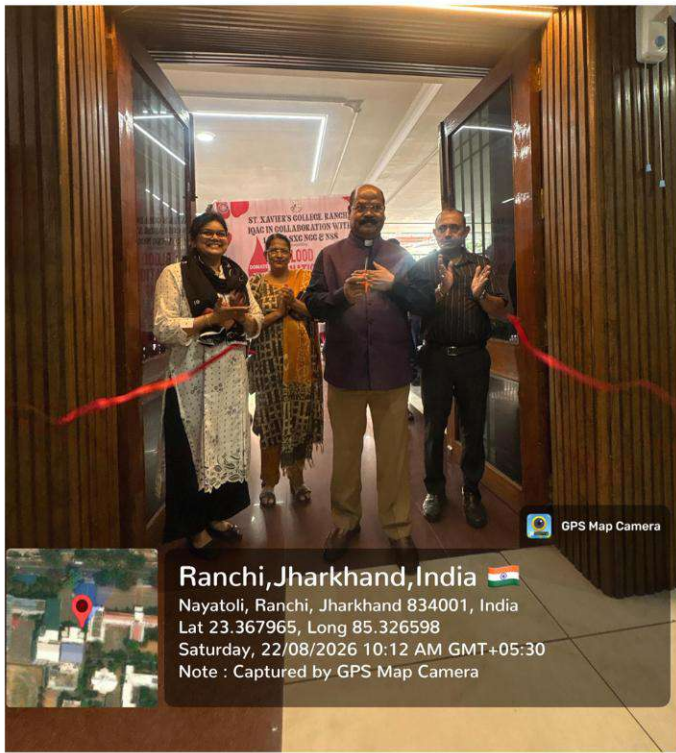
"Blood donation is not just about donating blood, it's about donating life, hope, and a second chance."
