World Aids Day

To commemorate **World AIDS Day**, an impactful **Awareness Talk** was organised by **1/3 COY NCC St. Xavier's College, Ranchi** in collaboration with **IQAC Jharkhand Swabhiman** on **1st December, 2025** at **Sadar Hospital, Ranchi** with the theme **"Overcoming disruption, transforming the AIDS response"**.

The event began with an informative session by **Chief Guests Shri S. Shyamal (Chief of Health Dept. of Jharkhand)** and **Dr. Kamlesh Kumar (State Tuberculosis Officer)**, who highlighted the causes, modes of transmission, and available treatments related to HIV/AIDS.
